SOMETIME ABOUT 1770

the coastal population of Great Britain
and Ireland changed their attitude
towards the harvest of shipwreck
and began the germ of a service to rescue people
from the wrecks which were a common feature
of most maritime neighbourhoods.

The movement
may well have started in Bamburgh,
but everywhere the soil was ripe.

AT FIRST

such services were carried out in local boats.

They were what the Lifeboat Institution
now calls 'Shoreboat Services';

but by 1790
a specialised boat had been called for & designed
which somewhat lessened the risks.

three similar boats found places in Britain.
None the less casualties must have been heavy,
though there are few records
to guide one to an estimate.

THOSE WHO UNDERTOOK THIS WORK
set an example to civilisation which has today
been followed by a great part of Western Europe.

THE ROYAL NATIONAL
LIFEBOAT INSTITUTION
was founded in 1824 to supply equipment
and to co-ordinate local efforts;
but as it only gradually acquired the allegiance
of individual Lifeboat stations through its services
its record of the names of those
who died in the work
only begins in 1854.

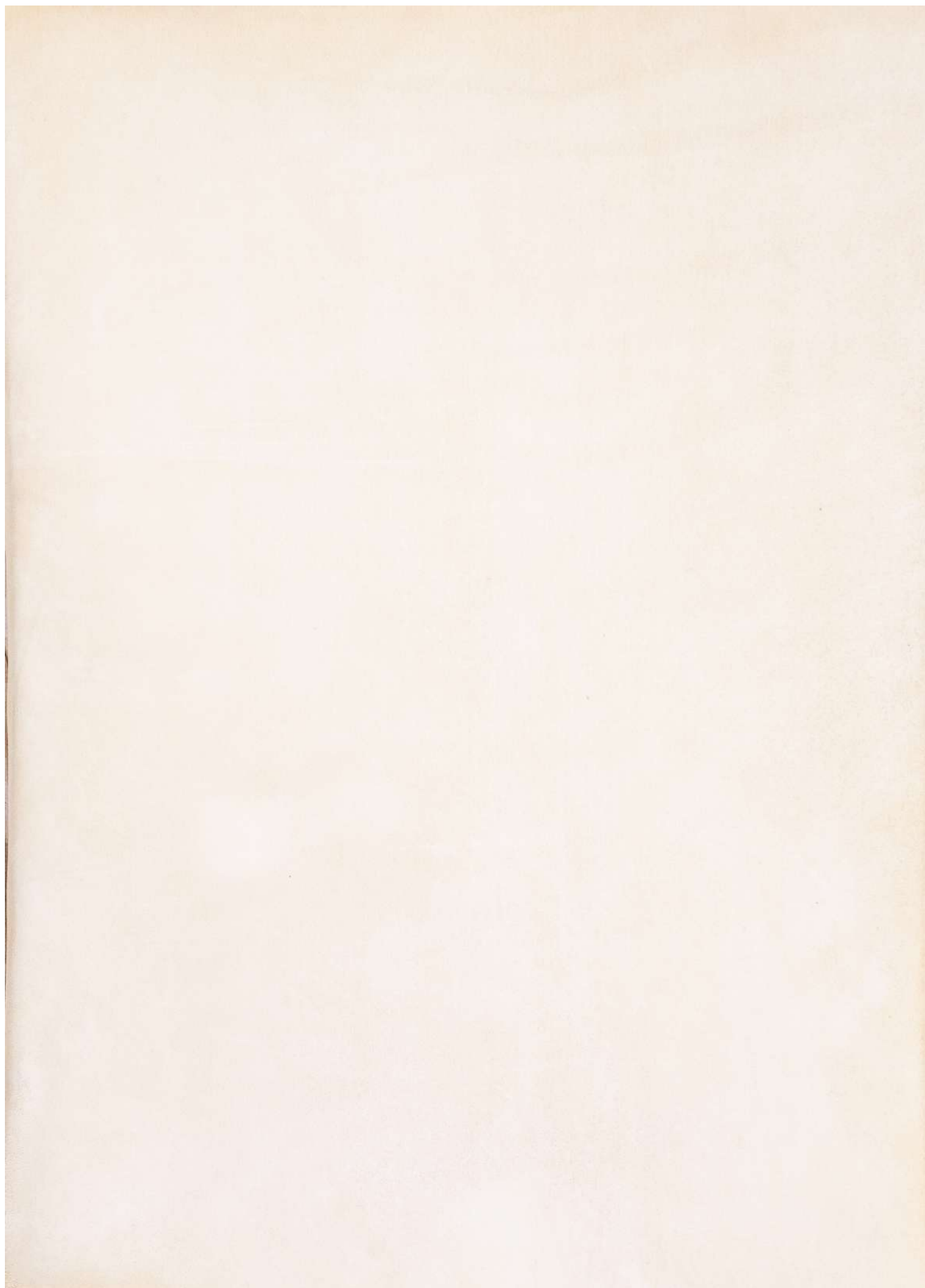
